Special Stuff for this year

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Packing Tips:

- Matter can neither be created nor destroyed – but it can gain in volume while at Pennsic. If you fill your car on the way out, it won't fit on the way back. This is a law of physics and can not be ignored. Trust me. (And don't get clever and think that you will eat the food, freeing up space. It doesn't work.)
- If it can leak, it will. Put it in a plastic bag.
- Put one set of modern clothes and one of medieval clothes in a plastic bag, and seal them. If possible, leave them in your car. Then, no matter what happens to your tent, you will have one set of clean, dry clothes.
- Pack things so when you get there, the stuff you need (like the tent, ground cloth and mallet) are accessible. That way, if it is damp, you don't have to put all your stuff on the wet ground to get to your tent.
- Pack things that are easily damaged (like bows and musical instruments) on top or get a hard case for them.
- Do NOT forget cash and a picture ID or you won't get past troll!
- Make certain you have all your prescriptions etc. (Remember that Chirurgeon's point will store prescription medications that require refrigeration.)
